The jury, which included Fernando Horcada, highlighted the quality of the works presented, both in execution and detail, as well as in the faithfulness of the representation of the original models.

With these awards, which this year celebrate their 17th edition under the claim 'Values and tradition', the Air Force and the SENER Foundation aim to contribute to the promotion of aeronautical culture, artistic creation and the dissemination of the values of the Air Force.
